

Refund policy for withdrawal from 2026 Competitions in Perth Western Australia

- No refunds for withdrawal will be made until after the World Champs is concluded.
- Refunds may be full or partial, being a proportional share of any surplus funds at the conclusion.

Reasons for this policy are provided in more detail below.

2026 FAI F2 World Championships for Control Line Model Aircraft.

At the time of all FEF's being received in February 2026, the expected income matched the expenditure budget required to hold a good competition in accordance with FAI/CIAM regulations.

Any significant refunds for withdrawals from 18th March 2026, will not permit the 2026 FAI F2 World Championships for Control Line Model Aircraft to be executed successfully.

As the expenditure for the event equals the income from entries and major financial support from Australian model aircraft bodies, there is no money available to pay refunds.

Should any funds be in surplus following completion of the championships, they would be distributed proportionally to all/any persons or teams that elected to withdraw.

- Refunds may be full or partial, depending on the amount of surplus funds upon conclusion.
- The time at which a withdrawal/refund request is made, will not impact the priority of payments.

2026 Control line World Cup of Australia.

This event was significantly subsidised by the World Championships budget. ie. bringing in Judges from overseas.

This event is only there to provide a support event for World champs competitors, and to enable some Australians to fly against world quality flyers.

- After 18th March there will no refunds for withdrawal.

Finally, please note –

- The 2026 FAI F2 World Championships for Control Line Model Aircraft Organization has no intent to cancel the competition.
- Non-refundable Payments and purchases already made do not permit the option of cancellation.
